- \$250 firing stipend
- Firing & materials fees at cost
- Paid teaching opportunities
- Invitation to sell work in The Shop
- Promotion through BCW marketing

• 7 hours/week as a Program Assistant

Lormina Salter Fellowship

- Awarded to one emerging artist for 1 year
- Includes the same benefits and responsibilities as Long-term Resident Artists plus \$1,200 annual materials stipend and solo exhibition

Short-term Residencies

- 1-3 months
- 24/7 access to a semi-private, 10'x12' studio space for \$200/month
- Firing & materials fees at cost
- Paid teaching opportunities
- Promotion through BCW marketing

Emerging Maryland BIPOC Artist Residency in Ceramics Inaugural Year 2022-23

- Awarded to one emerging BIPOC artist from MD (preferably Baltimore City) for 1 year
- Includes same benefits and responsibilities as Long-term, plus additional \$250 materials/firing stipend and exhibition in Solo Gallery
